

# Rooted in the Word weekly readings for

January 8-15, 2012

## Scripture: **Philippians 2:12-18**

Begin each daily devotional reading with prayer. Ask that God would speak to you through the Holy Spirit and His Word. Consider memorizing the passage or verse 13.

**January 8: Read I Timothy 2:1-7.** Spend time in prayer thanking God for his Word, asking that he would continue to speak to you through the Spirit, this passage and the message this Sunday morning.

**January 9: Read Philippians 2:12-18.** Read the passage slowly several times. What word or phrase draws your attention? Spend time reflecting on that word/phrase asking what God would say to you through it.

**January 10: Read Philippians 2:12-18.** Focus on verse 12. What does it mean for you to “continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling”?

**January 11: Read Philippians 2:12-18.** Focus on verse 13. How have you experienced God working “in you to will and to act according to his good purpose”?

**January 12: Read Philippians 2:12-18.** Focus on verse 14-15. What does “without complaining or arguing” have to do with becoming “blameless and pure, children of God?”

**January 13: Read Philippians 2:12-18.** Focus on verse 15. What does it look like in your life to be “pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation?”

**January 14: Read Philippians 2:12-18.** Focus on verse 16. What does it mean for you to “hold out the word of life?” How are you doing this in your context?

**January 15: Read Philippians 2:12-18.** Spend time in prayer thanking God for his Word, asking that he would continue to speak to you through the Spirit, this passage and the message on Sunday morning.
