Rooted in the Word weekly readings for: April 28-May 4, 2014 “Social” Justice

Begin each daily devotional reading with prayer. Ask that God would speak to you through His Word and through the Holy Spirit. Rekindle a sense of wonder, awe, or curiosity this week.

Apr. 28: Philippians 2:19-30. Having focused on this passage in last week’s devotions and in the worship service yesterday, what is the Lord asking of you in response?

Apr. 29: Is. 6. Read the passage slowly several times. Focus in on v. 3. What does this say about God? What are the implications in your life of this reality?

Apr. 30: Is. 1; 40. What roles does God play in these passages? What is the nature of relationship between God, humanity, and creation in these passages?

May 1: Is. 5:16; 30:18; 61:8-11. What characteristics show themselves as central to God’s character/will in these verses? What might be the implications for our daily life?

May 2: Is. 1:21-31; 28:16-17; 33:5. Look for recurring words in these passages, particularly for two words that appear close together? What do these words mean individually? How do they support one another when paired together?

May 3: Is. 5. What hopes does God have for his vineyard from its very inception? How emotionally attached is God to that plan? How does he respond when his vineyard has a mind of its own?

May 4: Is. 2, 32, 33. Find hope and vision in these passages. Spend time in prayer thanking God for His Word, asking that He would continue to speak to you through the
