

Rooted in the Word weekly readings for: February 24-March 2, 2014

Theme: Outreach...Christian Witness

Begin each daily devotional reading with prayer. Ask that God would speak to you through His Word and through the Holy Spirit.



February 24: Matthew 22: 34-40. Reflect on this statement from Jesus. We know it is often referred to as the greatest commandment but what is it saying to you as you consider local outreach and living a Christian witness.

February 25: Matthew 28: 16-20. You may have heard of the great commission numerous times, but this time read it carefully putting your name in the middle, how might you be called to live your life differently in light of this mandate.

February 26: Acts 9: 10-19 In these verses Ananias an ordinary person like you and I listens to God, steps out of his comfort zone and God works a miracle. What ways are you seeking to hear God or ignoring His call?

February 27: 1 Peter 4: 6-11. What are some common themes in these verses as you reflect on living our call to outreach and exemplify a Christian witness?

February 28: Matthew 9: 9-13 Being in relationship with the unbeliever or the new believer is so important to local outreach. Who is the tax collector in your life which you are sharing a meal with?

March 1: Luke 19: 1-10 Zacchaeus felt like an outsider in this story, what steps did Jesus take to help this man believe.

March 2: Reflect on the passages of this past week what themes stuck out to you as you reflect on local outreach and living a Christian Witness?
