

Rooted in the Word weekly readings for:

February 3-9, 2014

Scripture: Hebrews 1:1-4

Begin each daily devotional reading with prayer. Ask that God would speak to you through His Word and through the Holy Spirit.

February 3: Read Hebrew 1:1-4. This week's theme will be "Christ." What would be important for you to tell someone about Christ? What are the important topics that should be mentioned? What does today's scripture tell you about Christ?

February 4: Read Philippians 2:6-11. Today think about the topic of "Christ's incarnation." What scriptures reference his incarnation? How does this relate to our human experience?

February 5: Read Matthew 9:35-38. Today think about the topic of "Christ's life." Jesus spent his life in preaching (evangelism), teaching (nurturing in discipleship) and healing (binding up the brokenness of the world). How does this model true living?

February 6: Read Luke 23:26-56. Today think about the topic of "Christ's death." What is important for you as you think about this part of the story of Christ? What is the significance of his death for you?

February 7: Read I Corinthians 15:1-58. Today think about the topic of "Christ's resurrection." What is important as you think about the resurrection of Jesus? What is the importance of this for your life and faith?

February 8: Read Acts 1:1-11. Today think about the topic of "Christ's ascension." What does this passage tell us about Jesus and about our life and faith?

February 9: Read Hebrews 1:1-4. Spend time in prayer thanking God for His Word, asking that He would continue to speak to you through the Spirit, this passage and the message

on Sunday morning. Pray for the preacher and our congregation.
