

Rooted in the Word weekly readings for:

January 20-26, 2014

Scripture: Genesis 3:1-19

Begin each daily devotional reading with prayer. Ask that God would speak to you through His Word and through the Holy Spirit.

January 20: Read Genesis 3:1-19. This text tells us about the fall of humanity and the origin of sin in the world. On a piece of paper list all that this passage tells you about God, Satan, people, sin and judgment. How does this inform your life?

January 21: Read Genesis 4:3-16. Our text tells us about the second generation of humanity. What does it tell us about God, Satan, people, sin and judgment? Add these thoughts to your list from yesterday. Spend time reflecting on the image of sin in verse 7.

January 22: Read Genesis 6:5-7. What does this text tell us about God, Satan, people, sin and judgment? Add these thoughts to your list from Monday. Spend time reflecting on verse 6 and what it tells you about God.

January 23: Read Genesis 11:1-9. What does this text tell us about God, Satan, people, sin and judgment? Add these thoughts to your list from Monday. Spend time reflecting on verse 4 and what it tells you about sin.

January 24: Read II Samuel 11:1-27. As you read this text try to notice how temptation progressed to sin. There are several steps along that journey. What is the outcome of David's sin for the following: David, Bathsheba, Uriah, others involved, and God?

January 25: Read and reflect on "the Romans Road" (Romans 3:10, 3:23, 5:12, 6:23, 5:8, 10:9-10, and 10:13).

January 26: Read Genesis 3:1-19. Spend time in prayer thanking God for His Word, asking that He would continue to

speak to you through the Spirit, this passage and the message on Sunday morning. Pray for the preacher and our congregation.
