

Rooted in the Word weekly readings for:

March 10-16, 2014

Scripture: Philippians 1:1-11.

Begin each daily devotional reading with prayer. Ask that God would speak to you through His Word and through the Holy Spirit.

March 10: Read Acts 16:11-40. This text tells us about Paul's ministry in Philippi and the establishment of a house church in that community. What message might God want for you to hear today from this text?

March 11: Read the book of Philippians. As you read it ask God to speak to you about your Christian life? What message would God want you to hear today from this letter? What message would God want KMC to hear from this letter?

March 12: Read Philippians 1:1-11. Focus on verses 1-2. Who is writing this letter? Who are they addressing? How do they begin their correspondence? What strikes you in these verses?

March 13: Read Philippians 1:1-11. Focus on verses 3-6. Paul is speaking about his prayers for the church at Philippi. What does it tell us about Paul's relationship the church? How do you pray for your church? Of what is Paul confident in verse 6?

March 14: Read Philippians 1:1-11. Focus on verse 7-8. What strikes you about Paul's relationship with the Philippi church in these verses? How does this relate to your relationship with KMC?

March 15: Read Philippians 1:1-11. Focus on verses 9-11. What three things does Paul pray for (one from each of these three verses)? What would it mean for you to pray for these three things for yourself and for KMC?

March 16: Read Philippians 1:1-11. Spend time in prayer thanking God for His Word, asking that He would continue to

speak to you through the Spirit, this passage and the message on Sunday morning. Pray for the preacher and our congregation.
