

Rooted in the Word weekly readings for:

November 3-9, 2014

Scripture Reading: Luke 12:22-34

Our speaker on November 9 will be Kevin Himes, pastor of Salem Mennonite Church. On this Sunday he is with us as part of a pulpit exchange with Salem, Sonnenberg, and Kidron.

November 3: Read Luke 12:22-34. Read the passage several times. What word or phrase stands out to you as you read these verses? What might the Lord be wanting you to hear on this matter?

November 4: Read Luke 12:22-24. Focus on verses 22-23. What are the things that you worry about? How do they relate to this verse? Would the Lord say to you “do not worry” as he does in this passage? Why or why not?

November 5: Read Luke 12:22-34. Focus on verses 24-26. What do these verses tell us about God? What do these verses tell us about our worries? How does this apply to your life?

November 6: Read Luke 12:22-34. Focus on verses 27-29. What do these verses tell us about God? What do these verses tell us about our worries? How does this apply to your life?

November 7: Read Luke 12:22-34. Focus on verse 30. What does it mean for us to live differently than the world around us as it relates to the necessities of life? How are you doing in this part of your life?

November 8: Read Luke 12:22-34. Focus on verses 31-34. What do you hear the Lord saying to his people in these verses? What does that look like in your life? Where do you find these verses to be difficult? Why?

November 9: Spend time in prayer thanking God for His Word, asking that He would continue to speak to you through the Spirit, this passage and the message on Sunday morning. Pray for the preacher and our congregation.
